

# MDHIN PHARMACY PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

This Pharmacy Participation Agreement and Payer Setup Addendum (“Agreement”) is entered into between **MDHIN Corporation (“MDHIN”)** and the undersigned **Pharmacy**. This Agreement governs the Pharmacy’s participation in the MDHIN network, including pharmacy-based clinical services, dispensing under the MDHIN formulary, and adjudication through the MDHIN payer configuration in the Pharmacy Management System.

## 1. Purpose

Pharmacy will participate in the MDHIN network and may provide eligible services to MDHIN members under the RxDirectCare and related MDHIN programs. This Agreement is intended to support both: (a) pharmacy-based clinical encounters where permitted by law, and (b) dispensing of medications that appear on the then-current MDHIN formulary and fee schedule.

## 2. Services

Where permitted by applicable law, scope of practice, protocol, collaborative arrangement, and CLIA-waiver status, Pharmacy may provide or support:

- Minor illness / sick visit support, including common acute conditions under approved workflow or protocol.
- Wellness visits, nutrition guidance, lifestyle counseling, and chronic condition support.
- Care coordination, medication review, adherence support, and personalized therapy support.
- Point-of-care testing (POCT), including but not limited to A1C, lipid panel, strep, flu, and COVID, only where allowed and where Pharmacy maintains a valid CLIA waiver.
- Test-and-treat services, including rapid testing plus protocol-based assessment, only where allowed by law and program rules.
- Dispensing of covered medications from the MDHIN formulary pursuant to a valid prescription, standing order, protocol, or other lawful authorization.

## 3. MDHIN Formulary and Dispensing

Pharmacy may dispense medications only from the current MDHIN formulary and according to the fee schedule and operating rules issued by MDHIN. The formulary may include a limited list of low-cost generic medications and other approved products designated by MDHIN from time to time.

- Only formulary items approved by MDHIN for adjudication under the MDHIN BIN/PCN may be processed under this program.
- Each claim must identify the actual dispensed product and NDC, together with any other payer fields, service codes, or submission elements required by MDHIN.
- Pharmacy agrees not to substitute non-formulary products for MDHIN-covered items unless separately authorized and documented.
- MDHIN may update the formulary, eligible NDC list, reimbursement amounts, and operational instructions on prior notice to Pharmacy.

## 4. Reimbursement and Fee Schedule

Unless otherwise updated in writing by MDHIN, the following standard reimbursement categories apply:

For formulary medications, reimbursement is based on the current MDHIN formulary and fee schedule, which may be expressed as a flat fee, ingredient cost included fee, or other reimbursement methodology communicated by MDHIN. Pharmacy acknowledges that covered medication reimbursement includes the amount established by MDHIN for the applicable product or category and is limited to approved formulary items.

## 5. Billing Options

- MDHIN Billing Portal: Pharmacy may verify eligibility and submit eligible services through the MDHIN eligibility / billing process in accordance with MDHIN instructions.
- Pharmacy Management System Adjudication: Pharmacy may submit claims through the MDHIN payer setup using the MDHIN BIN, PCN, Group, and any related claim routing instructions provided by MDHIN.
- BIN/PCN workflow may be used both for clinical service categories identified by MDHIN and for covered formulary medication dispensing where activated by MDHIN.

## 6. Pharmacy Management System / Payer Setup Requirements

Pharmacy agrees to work with its pharmacy management system vendor, switch, PSAO, or internal IT team to configure MDHIN as an available payer for adjudication.

- Pharmacy will make commercially reasonable efforts to have the MDHIN BIN / PCN loaded and active in its Pharmacy Management System so that adjudication may occur in a standard pharmacy claim workflow.
- Pharmacy will use the current MDHIN payer setup document, formulary list, NDC list, and fee schedule supplied by MDHIN and will implement updates as they are released.
- If the Pharmacy Management System requires additional payer mapping, pharmacy network routing, processor control, NCPDP identifiers, or companion setup steps, Pharmacy and MDHIN will cooperate in good faith to complete the configuration.
- Pharmacy shall notify MDHIN promptly if claims reject, do not adjudicate correctly, or require updated payer setup information.

## 7. Claim Submission Rules

- All claims must be supported by appropriate eligibility verification, documentation, and legal authority for the service or medication dispensed.
- Where required, claims must include a Visit ID, appropriate diagnosis information, modifier requirements, and any additional claim fields communicated by MDHIN.
- For formulary dispensing, the actual dispensed NDC must match the approved formulary item and quantity dispensed.
- Pharmacy will retain records sufficient to support audits, member inquiries, reversal activity, and payment reconciliation.

## 8. Pharmacy Requirements and Compliance

- Maintain all required pharmacy licenses, permits, registrations, and professional oversight.
- Maintain a valid CLIA waiver for any POCT performed by the pharmacy, where required.
- Comply with HIPAA, applicable federal healthcare requirements, NCPDP transaction standards, and all applicable state law.
- Provide services only within the scope permitted in the state where the service is furnished and in accordance with applicable collaborative practice, protocol, or prescriber authorization requirements.

## 9. Updates to Program Materials

MDHIN may update the formulary, covered medication list, fee schedule, payer setup instructions, billing codes, submission rules, and operational workflows upon written notice. Pharmacy agrees to use the then-current MDHIN materials for all subsequent submissions.

## 10. Term and Termination

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days' written notice. MDHIN may suspend or terminate participation immediately for cause, including licensure issues, fraud, safety concerns, billing irregularities, or failure to comply with program requirements.

## 11. Confidentiality

Pharmacy shall maintain the confidentiality of all MDHIN member information and comply with HIPAA and other applicable privacy and security laws.

## 12. General Provisions

- Participation in MDHIN does not create an insurance relationship between MDHIN and Pharmacy.
- Pharmacy participates as an independent provider / contractor and is responsible for its own professional judgment and legal compliance.
- This Agreement shall be interpreted to comply with applicable federal law and the laws of the state in which the Pharmacy is domiciled or licensed to furnish the relevant service, unless the parties otherwise agree in writing.
- This Agreement may be supplemented by exhibits, payer setup sheets, formulary updates, fee schedules, workflow documents, or program notices issued by MDHIN.

By submitting the Pharmacy Participation Form, Pharmacy acknowledges and agrees to this Agreement and confirms it has authority to bind the organization. Submission constitutes a legally binding acceptance, effective as of the submission date.

- Formulary medication claims: adjudicate using actual approved formulary NDCs and the current MDHIN fee schedule.
- Current formulary, NDC list, and reimbursement schedule: maintained by MDHIN and incorporated into this Agreement by reference.
